NEW CLASSES

For 3-4 year olds- the basics of dance:

TWINKLE TOES (Mondays 3.30) DANCING DOTS (Saturday's 9am)

For 5-6 year olds - PRE PRIMARY BALLET (Thursday or Sat)

For 5-8 year olds Rosette 1 or 2 JAZZ. (Friday or Sat)

For 5 years plus – ACRO DANCE – On Saturdays.

For 5 years plus – PRE PRIMARY TAP – Friday's

For 9 years plus-Introductory Contemporary – Fridays.

For 9 years plus HIP HOP – Wednesday's.

ADULT CLASSES;

Ballet – Mondays or Thursdays.

Hip Hop – Monday's

Contemporary – Thursday's

MUSICAL THEATRE CREW – Mondays- By audition only.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

All items are available from ENCORE on George St. Some items available from ASHLEY ELLEN on Cuba. Hair must be up for all classes except Contemporary at times. Hair must be in a bun for Ballet from Grade 3 upwards please. Crossover wraps are optional.

PRE SCHOOLERS – TWINKLE TOES/FANCY FEET Own leotard and skirt or fairy dress. Ballet shoes are needed.

PRE PRIMARY /PRIMARY BALLET- Pink capped sleeved leotard (Chloe) and pink chiffon short wrap skirt with socks/ballet stockings and ballet shoes with elastic.

*GRADE 1 AND 2 BALLET- Pale blue leotard (Aimee) with ballet stockings and ballet shoes with elastic. Character skirt (3 blue ribbons preferred) and low heeled character shoes.

***GRADE 3 & 4 BALLET** – MAUVE LEOTARD with ballet stockings and ballet shoes with ribbons. Character skirt and Cuban heeled Character shoes.

*GRADE 5 BALLET- Navy leotard (Faith) with ballet stockings and ballet shoes with ribbons. Character skirt and Cuban heeled Character shoes.

*HIGHER GRADES/ VOCATIONAL BALLET- Navy/black shoestring strapped leotard. Ballet flats and pointe shoes (you will be instructed on when to get your pointe shoes). Character gear for higher grades. Demi-pointes as Miss Maxene tells you.

MODERN JAZZ-Rosette levels – Unitards. No shoes required.

Grade 2 – 6 JAZZ New strappy backed leotard (purple, turquiose, royal blue or red own choice) Black leggings & TAN Jazz shoes needed from Grade 3+ * Boys only – Personalised singlets can be purchased later in the year. Black shorts. Jazz shoes from Grade 3+. Long black sport pants higher levels.

* VOCATIONAL MODERN JAZZ— Leotard any style. Black nylon lycra leggings and TAN Jazz shoes.

*BEGINNERS- GRADE 2 TAP—Own leotard and skirt. Socks and Tap shoes.

*GRADE 3 TAP UPWARDS- Black leggings with own leotard/singlet top. Tap shoes— Oxford style from Grade 5 upwards.

*CONTEMPORARY– Black leotard and leggings

*HIP HOP 9+ CLASSES – Clothes that are easy to move in. Singlets can be purchased later in the year. No Jeans. Sneakers for Hip Hop.

***MUSICAL THEATRE CREW** - Clothes that are easy to move in. Singlets can be purchased later in the year. No Jeans.

ADULT CLASSES – Easy to move in gear. Ballet shoes for Ballet class. Sneakers for hip hop.

ENROLMENTS 2025: Existing students are automatically re-enrolled for 2025 once payment has been received. We have a lot of new classes on offer. Students training in more than one form of dance benefit greatly. It is suggested that from at least Grade 3 level two forms of dance are attended to help strengthen training. This really shows in the exam results also. As classes are filling up quickly please ensure you let Miss Maxene know your intentions for the year.
